

# Safety Survey



Unsecured objects that can move, break, or fall during an earthquake are potential safety hazards and may result in injuries. Walk through each room of your home and make note of these items, paying particular attention to tall, heavy, or expensive objects such as bookcases, home electronics, appliances (including water heaters), and items hanging from walls or ceilings. - Secure tall or heavy items with flexible fasteners, such as nylon straps or closed hooks, and relocate them away from beds and seating areas
- Ensure that flexible fittings and connections are installed on any gas appliances in your home
- Identify electrical, water, and gas shut offs in your home
- Instruct children how to properly shut off electrical, water, and gas connections
- Make sure flammable objects or liquids are located a safe distance from sources of heat or ignition
